**Model Shoots** – A historical park and a rustic building offer unique backdrops for model shoots.

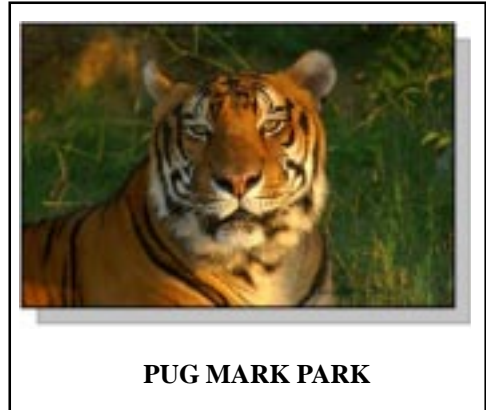
**Pug Mark Park**—Enjoy an up-close and personal tour of lions and tigers in McKinney, Texas.
